



Your Voice! Your Vote!



You must be at least 18 years old on Election Day, a Texas resident, and a US Citizen.

Already registered? Make sure your information is up-to-date. Go to **HarrisVotes.com** to check!

Weeks before an election, you can go and find out exactly what candidates and races are on your ballot at **HarrisVotes.com**. Bring your printed sample ballot or handwritten notes with you when you vote!

You can vote at any polling location in Harris County. Pick a location, date (early voting or Election Day), and time convenient for you. You can even check wait times at **HarrisVotes.com!**

- Texas ID Card (issued by DPS)
- Texas Driver License
- Texas Handgun License
- Texas Election Identification Certificate
- US Passport
- US Citizenship Certificate with photo
- US Military ID with photo

1. **INSERT** your ballot paper into the voting machine.
Note: Longer ballots may use more than one sheet of paper. Insert the ballot paper one sheet at a time, and follow the directions on the screen.
2. **VOTE** by making your selection using the touchscreen or access device.
3. **PRINT** and review your choices (you can make corrections up to two more times).
4. **SCAN** your ballot near the exit. When you see the flag on the screen, you've officially cast your ballot!

- **Voter Registration Deadline** – October 10
- **Early Voting** – October 23 – November 3
- **Mail Ballot Application Deadline** – October 27
(It must be received by our office by this date)
- **Mail Ballot Deadline** – Must be postmarked by November 7 and received by the elections office by 5 p.m. November 8. Voters delivering their mail ballot in-person have until 7 p.m. on November 7
