ELECTION DAY VOTE CENTERS

328 more than the next closest Texas county. Vote Centers spans 1,778 square-miles

EXPECTED VOTER TURNOUT IN HARRIS COUNTY (65%)

POLLS CLOSE AT 7 PM

- Finish processing all voters who are in line by 7 PM
- Takes judge approximately 1 hour to close Vote Center
- The Chain of Custody documents are then sign to begin the transport of the election equipment to Central Count.

TRANSPORTATION OF BALLOTS

- Election equipment is transported from 782 Vote Centers to Central Count (NRG Arena, Hall D)
- 45 Tents will process incoming equipment
- Average 5-7 minutes processing per vehicle

RECEIVING AND VERIFICATION

- Clerks open the sealed scan, verifies and ensures that all of the serial numbers and poll codes align
- Sealed V-Drive is removed for tabulation
- Average 5-15 minutes process per Scan

CENTRAL COUNT

- V-Drive is certified and entered into Central Count tabulation machine
- Average 2 minutes per V-Drive. Can process two V-Drives at a time
